**Admission to all Advanced level classes requires permission from the instructor.

Special Notes: Ballet III & IV meet 2/week, and students dancing *en pointe* are required to take the pointe technique class. Advanced Ballet meets 4/week. Students are required to attend all classes.

Ballet training is strongly recommended for students who wish to enroll in Modern Dance and Jazz classes. Please ask which ballet class would be appropriate for you.

Attendance Policy for Advanced Level Classes: Dancing is a commitment to rigorous training. Regular, consistent attendance to dance class is essential to success at any level and at all ages, but it is crucial to students who have reached the intermediate and advanced levels of their dance training. Therefore, all students in Intermediate and Advanced Ballet, Modern, Jazz and Tap are required to attend all classes. Students are permitted three *unexcused* absences per semester. In cases of family emergencies, illness or particular school functions, special allowances will be made as long as the instructor has been informed by the parent. Any classes that are missed must be made up in other classes, or they will be counted as unexcused absences. There will be no reimbursement of tuition fees, and the privilege of performing with the advanced class may be revoked.

Stage rehearsals for the spring shows are mandatory for ALL students. Any student who misses rehearsal without prior approval by the instructor, is subject to being removed from all performances.
