## 2021-22 DRESS CODE

POLICY: A student who comes to class properly dressed and ready to dance is better prepared for the discipline and commitment that is essential for success. Therefore, it is our policy that all students (Level I and up) comply with the dress code detailed below. Students who repeatedly come to class without the proper attire will not be permitted to participate, and will be required to observe class instead.

**GIRLS' HAIR MUST BE FASTENED SECURELY INTO A BUN FOR BALLET CLASS AND MAY BE WORN IN A PONY TAIL FOR JAZZ, TAP, MUSICAL THEATER, HIP-HOP OR MODERN. SHORTER HAIR MUST BE SECURED AWAY FROM FACE WITH CLIPS OR HAIR BAND.**

Light Blue Short-Sleeve Leotard & Blue Dance Skirt (optional)

Pink Footed Tights (optional on very warm days)

Pink Ballet Shoes

### **BALLET III & IV:**

Burgundy Tank or Camisole Leotard

Pink Footed or Convertible Tights

Coordinating Dance Skirt (Optional)

Pink Ballet Shoes

Pointe Shoes, when required (TBA)

### **ADVANCED BALLET:**

Black Leotard (any style)

Pink Footed Tights

Coordinating Dance Skirt (Optional)

Pink Ballet Shoes

Pointe Shoes, when required (TBA)

### **TAP & JAZZ & MUSICAL THEATER**

Leotard (matching level of class)

Tights - tan or pink (optional)

Jazz Pants, Leggings or Dance Shorts - Black

Tap or Jazz Shoes

**MODERN DANCE:** Jazz / Yoga Pants or Dance Shorts & Leotard (NO T-SHIRTS); No Shoes

**HIP-HOP:** Loose fitting, comfortable clothes; jazz sneakers; no street shoes, please

**BOYS:** White T-Shirt

Black Jazz Pants or Shorts

Black Ballet, Jazz, or Tap Shoes (as appropriate)
